PARISH ANNOUNCEMENT

**Please read the announcement BEFORE the beginning of
The Lord's Supper Celebration**

1. At the end of the Mass the Blessed Sacrament will be transferred to room A&B and reserved there until 2PM on Holy Saturday. All are welcome to pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament.
2. The Liturgy schedule for the Pascal Triduum & Easter Sunday is as follows:
 - April 18th Good Friday:
 - Way of the Cross: English – 10AM & 6PM;
 - The Passion of the Lord: English – 3PM.
 - Fast and Abstinence: All faithful who have completed their 14th year are to abstain from meat. Those who have completed their 18th year but have not yet begun their 60th year are also obliged to fast.
 - April 19th The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night: English – 7PM & 9PM. There will be the blessing of water during the Easter Vigil. If you wish to take home the Holy Water, please bring your bottle filled with natural water with a pinch of salt and place it in front of the altar to be blessed during the Easter Vigil celebration. You can take it back when the Mass finishes.
 - April 20th Easter Sunday:
 - English – 7AM, 8AM, 9AM, 10AM, 11:30AM & 6PM at the church; 10:30AM & 1:30PM at the carpark.
 - Tagalog – 1PM, 2:30PM & 4PM at the church.

On Good Friday and Easter Sunday parking will not be available due to liturgical celebrations held at the carpark.

3. A Prayer Concert “Witness to the Light”, performed by various choirs of our Parish, will be held at Saint Joseph Church on Monday, the 5th of May, at 3PM to celebrate the 150th Anniversary of the Society of the Divine Word (SVD), our Parish Feast Day and the Jubilee Year 2025. All are welcome to come and to invite others to join us.
