The Consulate General of the Philippines in Hong Kong, in partnership with St. Joseph's Church, LBC Hong Kong, and Philippines Association of Hong Kong, invites everyone to celebrate Simbang Gabi Mass tonight at 9 pm at St. Joseph's Church and witness the awarding of the winners of the PaSTARan 2025 Belen-Making Contest with the theme "Banal na Pamilya, Tanglaw ng Kaligayahan at Pagmamahal" which will be held immediately after that Mass at our church.

    - (1) English masses:
      - a. December 24, Christmas Eve: 12Nn, 6pm, 8pm (at Carpark) & 10pm.
      - b. December 25, Christmas Day: 7am, 8am, 9am, 10am, 10:30am (at Carpark), 11:30am, 1:30 (at Carpark) & 6pm.
      - c. December 31, New Year Eve: both 6:00pm Mass & 10:45pm Mass will be celebrated as Thanksgiving Mass at the end of the Year.
      - d. January 1, New Year Day: 7am, 8am, 9am, 10am, 10:30am (at Carpark), 11:30am, 1:30 (at Carpark) & 6pm.
    - (2) Tagalog masses:
      - a. December 24, Christmas Eve: 8pm, 10pm (at Carpark).
      - b. December 25, Christmas Day: 1pm, 2:30pm, 4pm.
      - c. January 1, New Year Day: 1pm, 2:30pm, 4pm.
