PARISH ANNOUNCEMENT

1. New issue of the Parish Newsletter is being distributed today at church exits.
2. During Lunar New Year, on February 17th, 18th and 19th there will be Mass in English celebrated at 12:00 noon time. Red envelopes – hongbao – will be presented after the Mass.
3. February 18th is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. Ash will be distributed on that day during the Mass at 7:45am, 12pm, 12:30 pm at the carpark and 6pm, as well as during the anticipated Sunday Mass on February 21st (Saturday) and during all Sunday Masses on February 22nd.
4. On Ash Wednesday, February 18th, an additional Mass at 12:30 will be celebrated in English at the carpark.
5. This year Ash Wednesday coincides with the second day of the Lunar New Year. The faithful are dispensed from the obligation of fast and abstinence, however they are obliged to choose some other forms of penance or perform works of charity.
6. During Lent, Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday, after the 6 pm Mass. All are welcome to participate. The faithful can also meditate the Way of the Cross at any time following the fourteen Stations outside the church.
